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Sweet Days of Summer



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

• One In A Melon, June 2017

Additional supplies used:

- 144086 Lemon Lime Twist Classic Ink Pad
- 126944 Daffodil Delight Classic Ink Pad
- 140931 Basic Black Archival Ink Pad
- 141415 Emerald Envy Cardstock (5-1/2" x 8-1/2")

Instructions:

1. Fold Emerald Envy Cardstock in half.

- 144166 Pick a Pattern Washi Tape
- 141936 Labeler Alphabet stamp set
- 100082 Basic Black Stmapin' Write Marker
- 2. Gently open the seam of one of the printed bags and cut out a layer measuring 4" x 5-1/4". Adhere to card base at an angle using Snail adhesive.
- 3. Using the white circle die-cuts from the kit, stamp one melon with Emerald Envy and Melon Mambo ink. Use a Stampin' Write Marker to color in the seeds. Stamp another melon, using the Sweet stamp, with Emerald Envy and Lemon Lime Twist ink, and a third melon with Lemon Lime Twist and Daffodil Delight ink. Trim the tops of each melon to form a half circle. Adhere to card base with dimensional as shown.
- 4. Using the Labeler Alphabet stamp set and some scrap white paper from the kit, stamp DAYS, OF, and SUMMER with Basic Black Archival ink. Trim words into small strips.
- 5. Adhere a strip of Pick a Pattern Washi Tape along the bottom of the card, tucking it under the bottom melon. Use dimensional to adhere the words on top of the melon and washi tape as shown.
- 6. Cut two strips of twine from the kit approximately 8" long. Unravel the twine and tie a bow. Adhere with a glue dot.
- 7. Enjoy!

Pocketful of Fruit



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

Additional supplies used:

- 143719 Pocketful of Sunshine stamp set
- 115320 Melon Mambo Cardstock 4-1/4" x 11"
- 103579 Paper Snips

Instructions:

- 1. Ink the pocket image in Emerald Envy and stamp on the printed half of the note card, add the pocket detail in the same color, fussy cut with Paper Snips.
- 2. Cut one of the Crushed Curry banners in half. Add one half to the top center of the card base and the other half to the bottom center of the pocket.
- 3. Use adhesive on bottom of the banner and three sides of the pocket leaving the top the pocket open and add the pocket where shown.
- 4. Wrap the Melon mambo Baker's Twine around the card at the top of the pocket two times and finish with a bow at the top left corner of the pocket.
- 5. Ink the watermelon rind in Emerald Envy and the fruit in Melon Mambo, stamp them on the bland half of the note card and fussy cut with Paper Snips.
- 6. Add watermelon to the pocket.
- 7. Stamp greeting along the right side of the pocket in Melon Mambo Ink.
- 8. Enjoy!

Sweet One In A Melon



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

One In A Melon, June 2017

Additional supplies used:

- 131199, Crushed Curry Cardstock 11" x 4-1/4". Score and fold at 5-1/2"
- 100730, Whisper White Cardstock 5-1/4" x 4"
- 144086, Lemon Lime Twist Ink
- 141491, Classic Label Punch

Instructions:

- 1. Fold card base in half and glue the white layer to the front.
- 2. Using the tissue paper, cut a piece measuring 5" x 3-3/4". Glue to the center of the white layer.
- 3. Cut one of the cards from the kit on the score line. Set aside the white half. Using the designer paper half, cut (3) strips measuring 1" x 4-7/8". Glue one to each outside edge of the card front leaving the same spacing on all three outside edges. Glue the third strip in the center.
- 4. Glue one of the banners from the kit about 1-1/4" from the bottom using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 5. Using the white half from the card you cut, stamp one of each watermelon image. TIP: when inking the rind of the watermelon, ink with Lemon Lime Twist Ink first and then roll the outside edge in the Emerald Envy Ink. (Rock n Roll Technique) Hand-cut and glue the watermelon image with the word 'sweet' on the banner with Stampin' Dimensionals. For the other watermelon image, cut a slice out of it as shown on the card and glue in place using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6. Stamp the sentiment on the white scrap of cardstock using Melon Mambo Ink and cut out with the Classic Label Punch. Glue flat to the watermelons.

Sweet Watermelon Card



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

Additional supplies used:

- 100730 Whisper White Card Stock
- 141415 Emerald Envy Card Stock
- 126889 Stampin' Trimmer

Instructions:

- 104332 SNAIL Adhesive / 104331 Refill or Glue Stick
- 1. Cut circular tag in half. Apply glue stick or SNAIL to half circle card stock, smooth printed tissue paper onto card stock, and trim. Stamp rind image on 2 x 3" Whisper White CS with Emerald Envy ink. Cut out and glue onto half circle CS. TIP: To get a good image with solid photopolymer stamps, ink with Versamark before inking with Classic Ink, and make sure to stamp with foam or a mouse pad under the card stock.
- 2. Stamp sentiment on 1/2 x 3" strip of Whisper White CS with Emerald Envy ink and taper ends. Cut 3-3/8 x 4-1/2" rind-printed CS from box. TIP: Use heat gun to open up glued edge of box to avoid cutting open.
- 3. On 4-1/4 x 11" Whisper White card base, adhere 3-1/2 x 3-3/4" Emerald Envy CS. Add rind-printed CS to card front.
- 4. Assemble front tag as shown, adding 12" baker's twine to top. TIP: Run baker's twine between your finger nail and finger to smooth out the kinks from the packaging.
- 5. Use Dimensionals to attach front tag to card front.

Strawberry Candle



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

Additional supplies used:

- 126889 Paper Trimmer
- 129026 Fast Fuse
- 103579 Paper Snips
- 141682 Basic Black Baker's Twine

- 141701 Delicate White Doilies
- 129053 Heat Tool
- 102300 Bone Folder
- White candle*

Instructions:

*The candle shown is 6" tall and has a 3-3/4" diameter. But this project could be done with a slightly taller candle or one with a smaller diameter. So you may need to adjust measurement accordingly depending on the candle you use.

 Cut one piece of tissue (so the seeds are going downward) to 10-1/2" wide by 5-1/4" tall. Cut another to 1-3/4" wide by 5-1/4" tall. Wrap largest tissue around candle and hold in place. Use Heat Tool to soften the wax and bond the tissue to the candle. (The tissue paper in this kit is thick, so it will take a little more work than regular tissue paper to bond it to the candle.) Be careful not to burn your fingers when heating. Add Fast Fuse to the back of the smaller piece of tissue and patch the back of the candle where there is still a bit of white showing. Heat to bond.



2. Trim off the top 2" of one of the gift bags from the kit. Then open carefully at the seam. Apply Fast Fuse generously to the backside of this rind. Wrap and attach to the base of the candle.



- 3. Attach a ½ doily coming down from the top edge of the rind on the front side of the candle. Stamp a watermelon image on the circular white tag from the kit. Trim across the straight edge.
- 4. Curl stamped watermelon with a Bone Folder. And attach on top the doily using Fast Fuse.
- 5. Wrap Basic Black Twine twice around the candle and tie in a bow. Tip...Wrap twine a little lower than needed. Then when the bow is tied, slide the twine up a bit so that the word "sweet" is uncovered.
- 6. Caution: Do not leave candle unattended (as you should with all candles). But because of the way this is decorated, there is the chance that the papers could ignite. Just keep that in mind. Be safe.



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Hooray



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

Additional supplies used:

- 131527 Whisper White Note Cards & Envelopes
- 100730 Whisper White cardstock (3-3/8" x 4-7/8" & 1" x 4")

Instructions:

- 1. Stamp watermelon images randomly on 1" x 4" piece of Whisper White cardstock.
- 2. Cut off a 1" strip from one of the printed card bases and trim down to 4".
- 3. Disassemble one of the bags and cut a 1" x 4" piece from it.
- 4. Adhere all 3 of the previous strips to the 3-3/8" x 4-7/8" Whisper White piece.
- 5. Wrap twine (from kit) around panel and tie in a bow on the right side.
- 6. Don't throw away the negative piece from the banner die cuts. You'll find a section that it perfect for the Hooray greeting. Use scissors to trim off both sides to create a 6-sided shape. Stamp greeting and adhere to panel with foam dots.
- 7. Adhere completed panel to note card.
- 8. Enjoy!

Sweet Watermelon Card



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

• One in a Melon, June 2017

Additional supplies used:

- 115320 Melon Mambo- 8 ½" x 5 ½", score and fold at 4 ¼"
- 119683 Daffodil Delight- 3 5/8 x 5 1/8"
- 100730 Whisper White Cardstock- scrap

Instructions:

- 1. Cut one of the printed notecards to 3 1/2 x 5
- 2. Stamp Watermelon twice on scrap of Whisper White cardstock (once with "Sweet" watermelon center, once with "seeds" watermelon center). Cut out. Cut seeds watermelon into 4 wedges.
- 3. Pop Up "Sweet" watermelon on watercolor panel from kit. Tuck two wedges behind as shown.
- 4. Adhere printed notecard panel to Daffodil Delight panel. Tie Baker's Twine around card. Attach to Melon Mambo Card.
- 5. Pop Up watercolored panel on top of printed panel.

It's Your Day Watermelon Note Card



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

• One In A Melon, June 2017

Additional supplies used:

- 121045 Basic Black Cardstock
- 100730 Whisper White Cardstock
- 141491 Classic Label Punch
- 104332 SNAIL Adhesive
- 126889 Stampin' Paper Trimmer

Instructions:

- 1. Using the trimmer, cut a piece of Whisper White 3" x 3 1/4".
- Cut a piece of the pink watermelon tissue paper a bit larger then the white piece. Adhere the tissue to the white piece using SNAIL adhesive – be sure and get adhesives close to the edges so the tissue paper does not lift at the sides
- 3. Use the paper trimmer to cut two pieces of the green stripe from a section of the printed bag. Both pieces should ½" x 3 ¼". Adhere on to the white, pink covered piece with SNAIL adhesive.
- 4. Cut a piece of black card stock 3 ¹/₄" x 4 7/8". Adhere the white piece with the pink tissue and green strips.
- 5. Adhere the black piece to the front of one of the printed card bases from the kit adhere it on the left next to the fold and trim off the excess card on the right side of the card.
- 6. Stamp the words "It's Your Day" in Melon Mambo ink on to a scrap of Whisper White card stock.
- 7. Punch out the words with the Classic Label Punch.
- 8. Attach the label to the card with the mini dimensionals from the kit.
- 9. Cut approximately 20" of the Melon Mambo twine. Fold the twine in half and tie a bow (this will now be a double bow). Adhere the bow to the card with a mini glue dot from the kit.
- 10. Send this card to someone to celebrate their special day!

Many Layers Card



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

Additional supplies used:

- 140272 Whisper White Thick Card stock sized at 8 1/2 x 5 1/2" Scored at 4 1/4"
- 141415 Emerald Envy Card Stock sized at 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Gently unfold one of the treat bags and cut away a 3 3/4" by 5" rectangle.
- 2. Cut one of the Fruity note card in half. Cut the white side to 4 1/4" x 3". Cut the fruity side to 2 3/4" x 4".
- 3. Stamp the sentiments in Emerald Envy on the yellow water colour banner, add 2 leaves and cut away the excess.
- 4. Wrap Melon Mambo bakers twine around the top of the banner and tie a bow.
- 5. Add the banner to the fruity card stock using dimensionals.
- 6. Apply dimensionals to the back of the fruity card and adhere to the white card.
- 7. Adhere to the watermelon rind rectangle to the Emerald Envy card panel and adhere both pieces to the Whisper White card base.
- 8. Add the 3 layered card front pieces to the center of the rind paper using wet or dry adhesive.
- 9. Give the card to someone who deserves a treat.

It's Your Day Card



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Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

• One in a Melon (June 2017)

Additional supplies used:

• 115320 Melon Mambo Cardstock (4-1/4" x 11")

Instructions:

- 1. Score Melon Mambo cardstock at 5-1/2" and fold to make the card base.
- 2. Cut apart watermelon box and cut a piece down to 4-1/4" x 2-1/4". Adhere to the front of the card.
- 3. Cut the notecard front down to 1-1/2" x 5" and adhere to the front of the card.
- 4. Layer the die cut banner on the center of the card.
- 5. Stamp the watermelon images and sentiment on the die cut tag. Tie twine through the tag. Attach the mini clothespin.
- 6. Attach the round tag to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
