INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Fold Tahitian Tide card base in half and burnish fold.
- 2. Use Countryside Corners Dies (2nd largest) to die-cut an opening ³/₄" from the bottom of the 5-1/4" x 4" layer of Basic White Cardstock. Then, use the large detail bubble image to stamp the right bottom corner with Versamark ink and heat emboss in white.
- 3. Watercolor the 5" x 3-1/2" layer of watercolor paper. Squeeze Tahitian Tide and Azure Afternoon ink pads to pool ink in the lids. Use a large Water Painter to coat the back and front of the watercolor paper, so it doesn't curl. Paint with more Azure Afternoon on the bottom and Tahitian Tide ink near the top. Add more concentrated color to get a nice variation in tones. Set aside to dry.
- 4. Stamp large detail turtle on Basic White Cardstock as follows. First ink up the stamp with Versamark ink and then without stamping, ink up the stamp with Crumb Cake ink. Then, stamp and immediately cover with clear embossing powder. Heat set.
- 5. Use a large Water Painter and Tahitian Tide and Granny Apple Green ink to watercolor over the embossed turtle. (Don't worry about edges as it will be cut out.) Let dry and then fussy cut.
- 6. Use SEAL to adhere Window Sheet to the back of the die-cut Basic White layer and then add Foam Adhesive Strips to the back. Be sure to connect the strips so there are no gaps. Use SEAL to adhere watercolored background to card base and to adhere turtle in the lower right corner. Add a pile of Loose Silver Sequins to the center and then peel off the backing of the Foam Adhesive Strips and sandwich the sequins inside the shaker.
- 7. Use liquid glue to adhere the strip of More Dazzle Specialty Paper to the bottom of the Basic White layer.
- 8. Use a large Water Painter and Melon Mambo ink to watercolor the 3-1/2" x 2-1/4" strip of watercolor paper in an ombre pattern. Start with a light wash and then add horizontal swipes of more concentrated color. Let dry and then adhere an Adhesive Sheet to the back. Use Alphabet A La Mode Dies to die-cut the word ALOHA. Set aside.
- 9. Use Sweet Citrus stamps to stamp triple flowers with Versamark ink on Basic White Cardstock. Cover with white embossing powder and heat set. Repeat two more times. Watercolor flowers with Melon Mambo ink concentrating more color in the centers. Ink up leaf stamp with Granny Apple Green ink and then use the edge of a Garden Green ink pad to add darker color to just a portion of the stamp. Spritz and stamp on Basic White. Repeat one more time. Cut out all images with the coordinating Sweet Citrus Dies.
- 10. Stamp the large and small detailed starfish with Versamark ink on Basic White Cardstock and then heat emboss in white. Watercolor with Tahitian Tide ink. Fussy cut both.
- 11. Ink up the sand dollar with Crumb Cake ink and stamp off on scratch paper. Use a Sponge Dauber to add more Crumb Cake ink to one side, huff the stamp and stamp on Basic White Cardstock. Fussy cut.

- 12. Peel off the backing of the ALOHA letters and adhere 1/8" from the bottom of the layer. Adhere leaves with liquid glue. Arrange flowers and sand dollar and adhere with Dimensionals. Adhere two starfish with liquid glue.
- 13. Add 3 Flat Adhesive-Backed Pearls.
